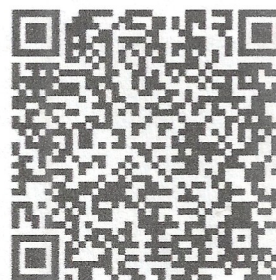


QUIZ COMPETITION
