A Call for Compassion and Action

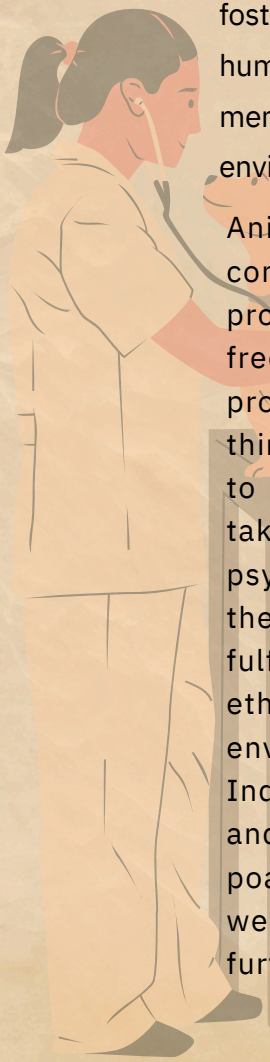

Will Rogers once said, *"Personally, I have always felt that the best doctor in the world is the Veterinarian. He can't ask his patients what is the matter, he's just got to know."*

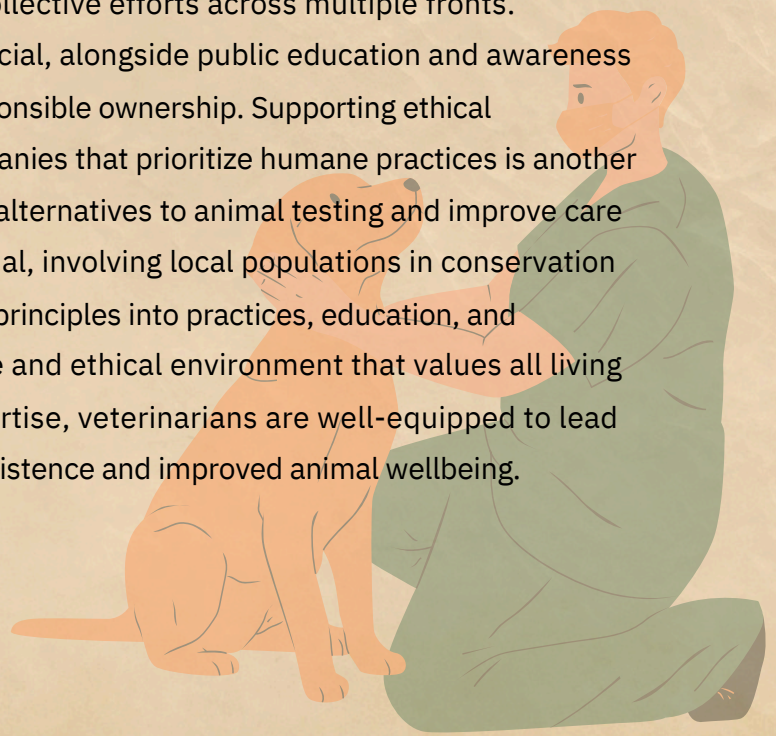
This sentiment resonates deeply with every veterinarian, reflecting the unique challenges and profound responsibility of their work. While many people assume that a veterinarian's role is limited to treating pets or managing livestock, this view misses the broader scope of the profession. Beyond medical care, veterinarians are vital to numerous areas that impact both animal and human health. They act as first responders during outbreaks of zoonotic diseases, ensure food safety and public health, and contribute to vaccine development. Additionally, the armed forces depend on veterinarians to care for military working animals such as dogs and horses. As a veterinarian, I take immense pride in being part of this noble profession. Yet, an often-overlooked aspect of veterinary work is the promotion of compassion and the safeguarding of lives through the advocacy of animal welfare and wellbeing, which fosters ethical coexistence. Animal welfare and wellbeing are integral to ensuring the humane and ethical treatment of animals. These concepts emphasize the physical and mental health of animals, striving to balance their needs with the demands of their environment.

Animal welfare refers to the state of an animal and its ability to cope with the conditions in which it lives. Good welfare is characterized by health, comfort, proper nourishment, safety, the ability to express natural behaviours, and freedom from pain, fear, or distress. The "Five Freedoms" framework provides a guideline for achieving this, focusing on freedom from hunger and thirst, discomfort, pain, injury or disease, fear and distress, and the freedom to express normal behaviour. Beyond welfare, the term animal wellbeing takes a more holistic approach, addressing both physical health and psychological state. It emphasizes not just the absence of suffering but also the promotion of positive experiences like joy, companionship, and the fulfilment of natural instincts. The importance of animal welfare is rooted in ethical considerations, legal obligations, economic impacts, and environmental balance. However, numerous challenges hinder its promotion. Industrial farming often prioritizes profit over welfare, resulting in stressful and cramped living conditions for animals. Wildlife exploitation, including poaching, habitat destruction, and illegal trade, also severely impacts welfare. Cultural practices, traditions, and a general lack of awareness further exacerbate the issue.



This brings us to the vital role of veterinarians, who are uniquely positioned as stakeholders with the expertise and skills necessary for animal welfare and wellbeing. According to the World Organisation for Animal Health, the responsibilities of veterinarians extend beyond clinical practice. They advocate for pet and livestock owners, raise public awareness about animal welfare, promote ethics in animal research, contribute to drafting welfare laws, and collaborate with organizations dedicated to animal rights. Animal wellbeing and welfare focus on the humane and ethical treatment of animals, emphasizing both their physical and mental health. Achieving this balance requires understanding and addressing the needs of animals within their environments. By fostering compassion and prioritizing animal welfare, veterinarians contribute to a more humane and ethically conscious society. We occupy a central role in the triadic relationship between animals, their owners, and society. This role, however, varies across regions and must be guided by scientific, objective, independent, and impartial practices. We play a critical role in promoting animal welfare as advocates, educators, and mediators. Veterinarians must educate pet and livestock owners on proper care and welfare standards and address unethical practices in farms, clinics, and fieldwork. In cases of human-animal conflict, veterinarians act as compassionate mediators to resolve issues equitably. They also contribute significantly to research ethics by implementing the principles of Replacement, Reduction, and Refinement (3Rs) in animal experimentation. Institutional Animal Ethics Committees now actively monitor research practices, reflecting a positive step forward. Furthermore, veterinarians play a pivotal role in drafting and enforcing animal welfare legislation, ensuring policies are grounded in scientific understanding and ethical considerations.

The promotion of animal welfare requires collective efforts across multiple fronts. Stronger legislation and enforcement are crucial, alongside public education and awareness campaigns about humane treatment and responsible ownership. Supporting ethical consumption by choosing products and companies that prioritize humane practices is another vital step. Research and innovation can offer alternatives to animal testing and improve care practices. Community engagement is essential, involving local populations in conservation and welfare initiatives. By integrating welfare principles into practices, education, and policies, society can create a compassionate and ethical environment that values all living beings. Through their unique skills and expertise, veterinarians are well-equipped to lead these efforts, fostering a future of ethical coexistence and improved animal wellbeing.



Despite the profession's commitment to animal welfare through advancements in husbandry, hygiene, preventive medicine, and treatment, there remains a gap in addressing how animals *feel*. Veterinary engagement in animal welfare must encompass a wide range of activities, including:

Daily Veterinary Practices: Veterinarians are professionally obligated to demonstrate care and compassion in their routine interactions with animals. This includes providing appropriate medical care, preventing disease, implementing effective management protocols, and ensuring qualified staff handle animals with minimal stress and maximum empathy.

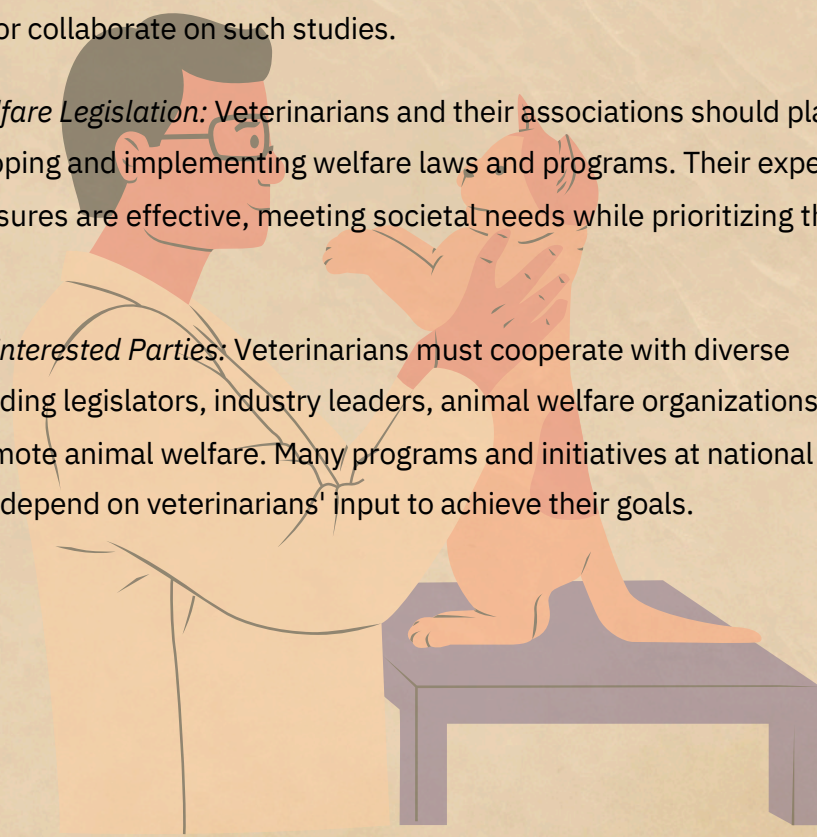
Advocacy to Animal Owners: Veterinarians are uniquely equipped with scientific and medical training, as well as statutory accountability, to ensure welfare standards are met. They educate animal owners, managers, and communities on best practices in animal management and motivate them to improve welfare practices.

Education and Public Awareness: Veterinarians serve as a primary source of science-based expertise on animal welfare for the general public. As urban populations grow increasingly distanced from basic animal husbandry practices, veterinarians must step in to educate people on responsible pet ownership and the humane treatment of animals.

Animal Welfare Research: Animal welfare is a multidisciplinary field involving veterinary science, ethics, religion, politics, and economics. Further research is essential to uncover best practices for improving welfare. Veterinarians, with their training and accountability, are well-suited to lead or collaborate on such studies.

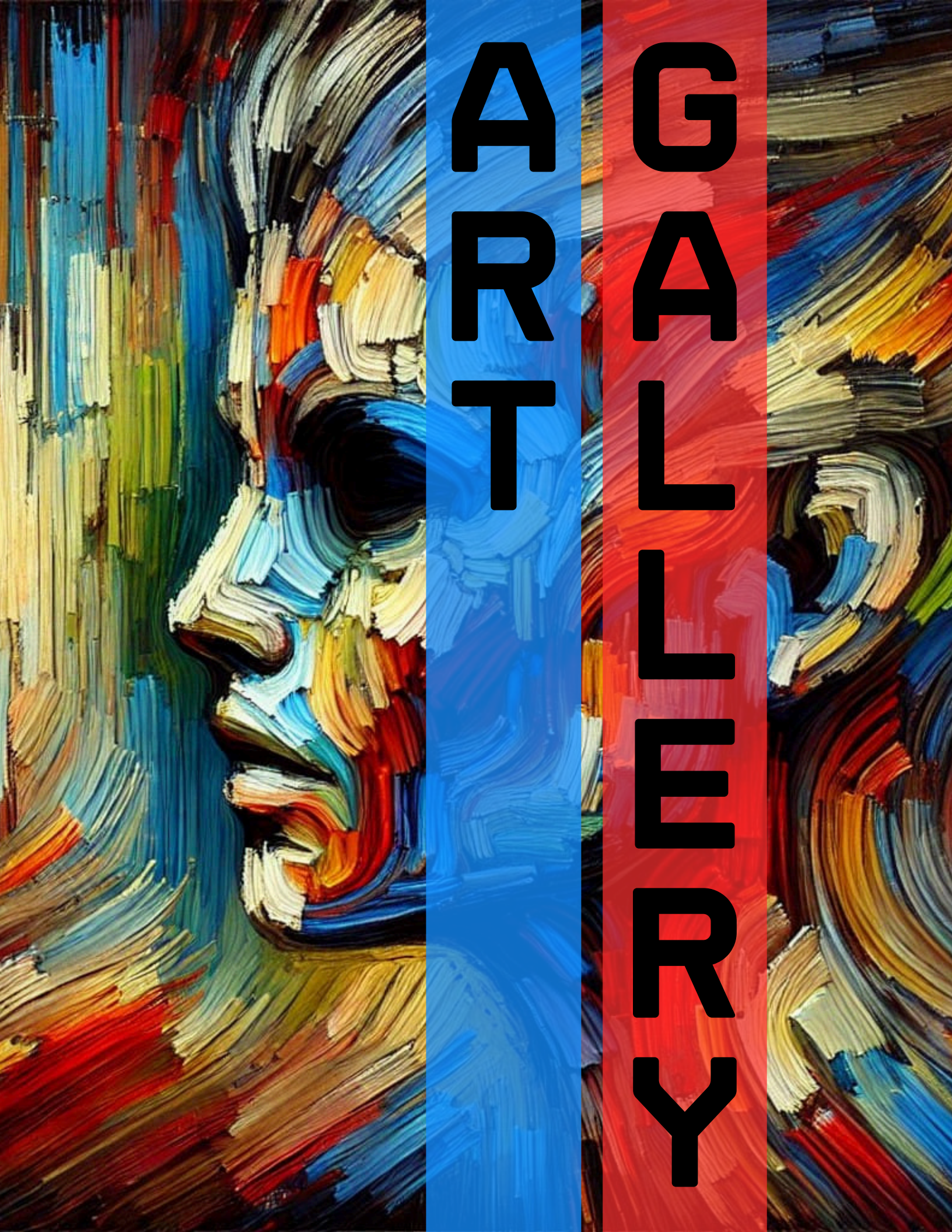
Drafting Animal Welfare Legislation: Veterinarians and their associations should play an active role in developing and implementing welfare laws and programs. Their expertise ensures these measures are effective, meeting societal needs while prioritizing the wellbeing of animals.

Collaboration with Interested Parties: Veterinarians must cooperate with diverse stakeholders—including legislators, industry leaders, animal welfare organizations, and consumers—to promote animal welfare. Many programs and initiatives at national and international levels depend on veterinarians' input to achieve their goals.

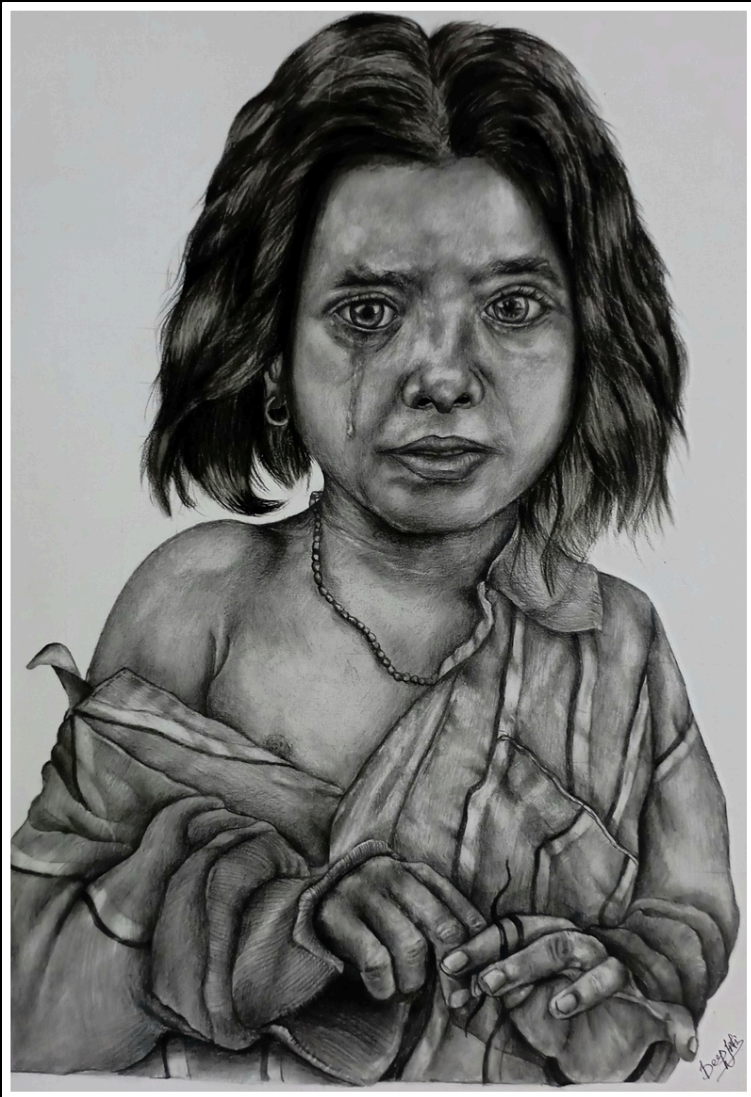
